Ommen, May 17 1841? 1940?

My Dear Brother!

Grace be with you, Amen!

Your request for a letter of transfer for Brother Veenstra is
superfluous because for some time this already has been given
to him.

We have nothing against his ^{recognition} ~~working~~ in your congregation but
feel it is our bounden duty to protest his admittance to the
Ministry ~~unless he~~ ^{would} present himself somewhere to be examined.

We will develop this later when

The Lord Be Your Delight.

Your ~~praying~~ brother in the Faith.

Your brother \rightarrow A.C. Van Raalte.
