I have the honor to return the petition enclosed in Your Excellency's letter of March 17 last, No. 9, which had come from A.C. Van Raalte, *cum suis*, requesting recognition of a Christian *afgescheidene* church in <u>Ommen</u>.

I sent this petition to the mayor of the town of Ommen, so that the petitioners can present as addendi the regulations and further documents, intended by His Majesty's resolution of last January 9 (*Staatsblad*, No. 2). Furthermore, the head of the local governing body must see to it that the signatures under the petition as well as under other documents are legalized. I received a letter from the mayor (a copy of which is enclosed) on the second of this month, accompanied by the letter (the original is enclosed hereby) of two of the first signatories of that petition, one of
