The governor of the province of North Brabant declares: that Albertus Christiaan Van Raalte, born in Wanneperveen on Oct. 17, 1811, son of Albertus and Catharina Christina Harking, has been registered in the town of Fijnaart for the National Militia; that his number, by lottery, was nine, and that the Military Council which met in Breda has subsequently exempted him completely in his capacity as pastor.

Issued in 's Hertogenbosch, on Nov. 20, 1835, by the Governor.....[illegible signature]
