56 Cedar St., New York City

President Philip Phelps, Jr. penned a note to Gerrit Van Schelven, treasurer pro tem of Hope College on this date sending him \$36.00 which are the funds collected for the third term. Of this, Phelps asks him to pay Dr. [Albertus C.] Van Raalte \$35.00 which VR advanced to the Hope College Council at its last meeting.

This note is attached to a memo of Van Schelven of August 2 to Van Raalte with the payment of the \$35 which were advanced for traveling expenses. Van Raalte responds on August 3 accepting the funds which were used for the traveling expenses of the Council members but he also returns \$5.00 because he advanced \$30 and not \$35.
