BELL, Auditor General of the State of Michigan, of the first part and Albertus Christian, of the second part, Witnesseth That Whereas, in pursuance of the provisions of Law, the said part of of the State became the purchaser of the rights of the State in and to the following described LANDS were bid off to the State for the Taxes assessed thereon in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty One, Fifty Seven Thousand and one hundred and thirty four, in Township Eighty one acres and forty five hundredths of

And Whereas, the said part of of the second part obtained a Certificate from the State Treasurer for the above described Lands, according to Law, and paid to the State Treasurer, up Thirty Nine Cents, being the amount of purchase money thereof, as provided in the Statute in that behalf made.
