ARTICLE 28

The assembly decided to adjourn until this afternoon at 1:30, and was closed with prayer by --- .

AFTERNOON

SESSION OF THE SECOND DAY

ARTICLE 29

The meeting was opened with the singing of Psalm 90: 9, and with prayer by Rev. W. Moerdijk.

ARTICLE 30

The situation in the Reformed Church of Rotterdam, Kansas, was discussed, and it was decided that Dr. A. C. van Raalte should visit that congregation.

ARTICLE 31

The report of the treasurer of the school board, Mr. G. Wakker, was read, received, and approved.

ARTICLE 32

The meeting adjourned until April, 1873, and was closed with prayer by Rev. P. de Pree.
