September 17, 1872

The program of the 25th anniversary celebration of the founding of the Colony. A parade formed at the Public Square and proceeded to the "Estate of Van Duren, one mile East of Holland City,..." One carriage contained eleven young ladies who represented the eleven provinces of the Netherlands. Speakers included ACVR, Isaac Fairbanks and H. D. Post, Rev. H. Uiterwijk or Rev. C. Van der Veen, Rev. Ph. Phelps or Rev. R. Pieters, Rev. C. Van der Meulen, T. Keppel, B. Ledeboer "and other"! Kommer Schaddelee was "president of the day." The Van Lente choir provided the music along with the Holland bands. Fifteen surviving first Settlers came in a wagon drawn by "2 Yoke of Cattle." By having the celebration east of the city and with Pastor Cornelius Vander Meulen as a participant, there was an attempt to give the appearance of a joint celebration with the Zeeland people.
