A bond, worth \$4,739.68, owned by Courtland Palmer, for a loan to Van Raalte who is to repay the loan in five installment. The bond was apparently sold later to James Suydam and Samuel B. Schieffelin.

United States of America, to be paid to the said Coullandt  
Palmer

or to his certain Attorney, Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or  
Assigns. to which payment, well and truly to be made, I bind  
myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, and  
each and every of them, firmly by these  
presents. Sealed with my seal, dated the Eleventh  
day of November one thousand eight hundred and forty seven

The Condition of this Obligation is such, that if the above  
bounden Albertus C. Van Raalte,

his Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, or any of them,  
shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the abovementioned  
Coullandt Palmer

or to his certain attorney, executors, administrators, or assigns, the  
just and full sum of ~~One hundred and fifteen 7/8 dollars~~  
~~with interest within two years from the date hereof,~~  
~~Also the further sum of Two thousand seven~~  
hundred and thirty nine <sup>68</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars, in five  
equal annual payments, with interest from  
and after the first day of January next,

without any fraud, or other delay, then this obligation to be void, and of  
none effect, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

For and in consideration of \$1828.40 to me paid, I do hereby bargain, sell & assign unto James Suydam and Samuel B. Schieffelin, of the City and State of New York, the within Bond, and all sum or sums of money due or to become due thereon - and I authorize & bind the party of second part to in their name to ask, demand, sue for, recover, receive & keep the money due, & that every good due thereon - and I do covenant that there is now due thereon the sum of \$1828.40 - for principal & interest -
