both sexes until the next meeting of
Council, provided that suitable facilities
be furnished especially through the
appointment of a Deacon and that the
President of the College be requested to
bring this subject before the Committee
at an early day.

Res 1st
The following paper was read & adopted
Resolved that in view of the ^{prob} proposed absence
in order to prosecute the financial
work at the East, the Pres. of the College
requested the ~~appointment~~ approval of
the Executive Committee for the
following arrangement in his absence.
