June 4, 1849

A letter to ACVR from John J. Adam, Auditor General, Lansing, Michigan, who notified ACVR that the purchase of a piece of property by ACVR was invalid. If he presented the certificate of purchase to the state, ACVR would have his money refunded.

Dear Sir:- The purchase by you, at this office, of the Undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ of N 27th sec. 30, T 5 N., R. 15 W., has been found invalid, for the reason that the land was sold by the U. S. as lot No. 1, in said section, and it should have been accepted as such.

Upon return of your certificate of purchase of said description, the purchase money will be refunded.
