Shipped, IN GOOD ORDER AND CONDITION, by G. B. ALBEE, for account and at the risk of whom it may concern, on board the Constitution whereof _____ is Master, now lying at the PORT OF GRAND HAVEN, and bound for Holland the following articles as here marked and described, to be delivered in like good order and condition, as addressed on the margin, or to his or their assigns, or consignees, upon paying the freight and charges, as noted below, (dangers of navigation excepted.)

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Master of said Vessel hath affirmed to 3 Bills of Lading of this tenor and date, one of which being accomplished, the other to stand void.
