An agreement between ACVR and his son with Warren Wilder,
dissolving their partnership which had been made on March 16,
1864.

This agreement made the twenty seventh day of July, A.D. 1864, between Warren Wilder, of the one part, Albertus Van Raalte, of the second part, and Albertus C. Van Raalte, of the third part, all of the County of Ottawa and State of Michigan, Witnesseth: _____

That the copartnership heretofore existing between the parties above named, under the firm name and style of Wilder & Company, pursuant to Articles of Copartnership made in writing between said parties and dated the 16th day of March, 1864, is hereby dissolved and the said articles of agreement and all copartnership business excepting so far as relates to doning[?] up the concern shall henceforth cease and determine.

And the said Warren Wilder has this day, sold, conveyed, transferred and made over to said Albertus C. Van Raalte, all of his interest in the said copartnership and all his interest right and title in and to the property, both real and personal of every name or nature belonging to or connected with said copartnership, or the business carried on by said copartnership, for the sum of seventeen hundred dollars, of which amount five

hundred dollars is to be paid down and twleve hundred dollars, with interest at ten per cent is to be paid in three equal payments of \$400. each in one, two and three years, as appears from notes and mortgage of such date given by said Albertus C. Van Raalte to secure such payment.

And said Warren Wilder is to be cleared and is hereby released from paying my debts or claims against said copartnership that may be yet outstanding, and the said Albertus C. Van Raalte is to protect said Wilder against all such debts and claims and save said Wilder ----less[?] from any payments, costs or charges on account of such debts or claims, as will more fully appear from his bond of indemnity of this date executed by said Albertus C. Van Raalte to said Wilder, in witness whereof the said parties have hereto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
