SPECIAL MEETING.

Office of Secretary Board of Education, Holland, March 13th, A. D. 1879.

TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF HOLLAND:

NOTICE is hereby given that at a meeting of the "Board of Education of the Public Schools of the City of Holland," held March, 10th, A. D. 1879, the following preamble and resolutions were adopted and ordered to be submitted to the vote of the electors of said City, viz:

Whereas, a greater sum will be required during the year; (sum has been provided for by the Board of Education) for the purpose of erecting the proposed new school building, and whereas such additional sum (not exceeding one per cent of the taxable valuation of the City for the preceding year) cannot be raised by the Board, unless authorized thereto by a majority vote of the electors of the district present at a special meeting called by the Board for the purpose of voting thereon, therefore be it

Resolved, That in furtherance of the proposed erection of such new school building, it is hereby ordered that the Board of Education, acting for and in behalf of the Public Schools of the City of Holland, borrow the further sum of four thousand dollars; said sum being not in excess of one per cent of the taxable valuation of the City as shown by the tax-roll of the preceding year; that the terms upon and the time for which said amount shall be borrowed are as follows: One thousand dollars to be paid January 1st, A. D. 1889; One thousand dollars to be paid January 1st, A. D. 1890; One thousand dollars to be paid January 1st, A. D. 1891, and One thousand dollars to be paid January 1st, A. D. 1892, all bearing interest at the rate of not

De vergadering zal plaats hebben, in het Union schoolgebouw, op Maandag, 31 Maart, des avonds ten 7 ure. Wij hopen dat de stengeregigden der School Board zullen a terken in hun voorgenoemd plan, en eene omroepige bezwaren in den weg leggen.
