Biography

Hope College class of 1935; Western Theological Seminary class of 1938; Reformed Church in America minister, 1938-1962; Hope College Director of Development, 1962-1965. Adelpfos A. Dykstra died in Roxbury, New York, on November 4, 1966.

Scope and Content
