The General Synod of the Reformed Church in America reposing confidence in your piety, learning and talents have elected you a Professor in their Theological College at Holland Mich.

The branches in which you are to instruct the youth committed to your charge are those of Evangelistic Theology with such modifications as the Synod may hereafter direct.

For the assumption of the powers and the execution of <sup>the duties</sup> your office in the Theological Department of the College this is your Commission and may the Head of ~~the~~ Church render your labors useful and pleasant.
